
The Space of Transcendence: The Middle Ages

Rise of Modern Science




Modern science brought with it the conquering of space

God was pushed out of the cosmos as an "unnecessary hypothesis."






Descartes Error

- Body = matter= machine.



The Hard Problem of Matter

Quantum Reality

- Matter is not composed of basic building blocks but complicated webs of relations
- Cosmic life is intrinsically relational.
- Interconnectedness lies at core of all that exists.

Quantum Entanglement

- Take two particles whose spins cancel each other out to zero. Separate particles by distance. If measure particle A as "up" particle B is measured "down."
- The measurement on A does not merely reveal an already established state of B: It actually produces that state → entangled.

Unitive Reality: Love is the power of attraction

- Attraction is prior to Being; Being flows from union
- Union is always towards more being.

Religious experience is part of the inside story of the universe


"Religion is biologically the necessary counterpart to the release of the earth's spiritual energy..."
