Her many books include *Making All Things New*, a finalist for the Michael Ramsey Prize, and *The Unbearable Wholeness of Being*, for which she won the Silver Nautilus Book Award and a Catholic Press Association Book Award in Faith and Science. She is founder of the Center for Christogenesis, an online resource for the integration of science, religion and culture.
